Time	Activity/ Venue	Description
11.50-12.00	Sage Gateshead	Meet our Schools facilitator at the West entrance to Sage Gateshead
12.00-12.30	Sage Pop Up cinema (Brasserie, G Floor)	You will watch both the Great Exhibition of the North Arrival film telling the story across the North and a film screening of their major commission 'Bridges' - a brand new animated, musical adventure by artist Ed Carter that introduces the bridges of the River Tyne brought to life through music and animation.
12.30-13.00	Level 1 bar space around Sage 1	Sound drawing activity described in your teacher guide.
13.00-13.10	Performance square	Get North Water Sculpture- UK's largest water sculpture will perform every day of the Exhibition. 80m long and reaching the height of the Tyne Bridge, with three specially commissioned soundtracks available to download.
13.10-14.10	BALTIC Centre for Contemporary Art	Work your way round BALTIC, discovering how the North is explored and expressed through art. Each floor contains an exhibition that can be used to stimulate learning, through encouraging discussion, debate, and creativity. A resource will be available to guide teachers through the space. This resource will include key questions, curriculum links and example activities that can be done in BALTIC, as well as follow up activities that can be undertaken back in the classroom. There will also be the opportunity for students to work towards Arts Award Discover, through activities undertaken in the gallery.
